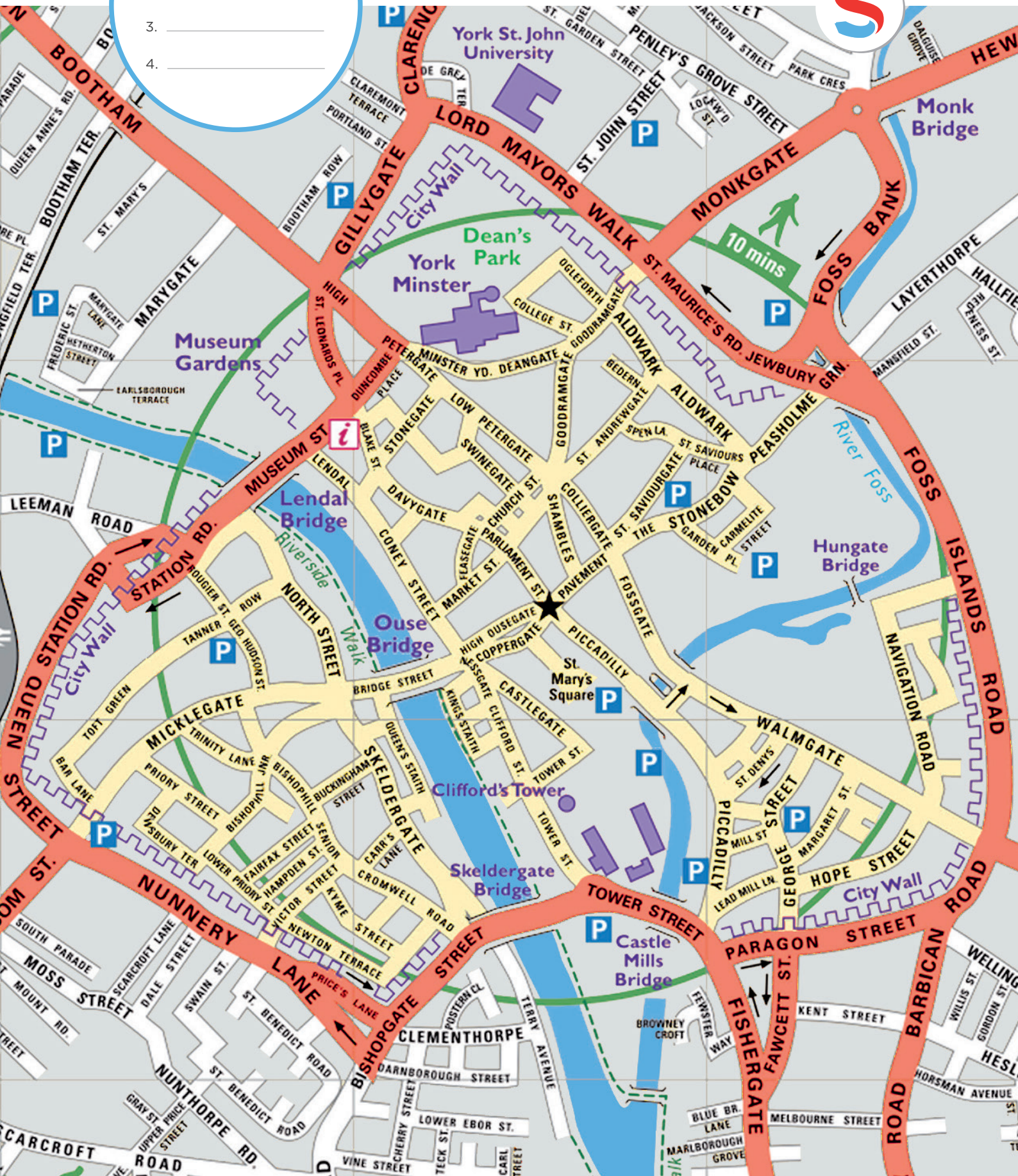

SOLUTION TO THE QUIZ

The order of the questions provides a logical and informative tour through York, starting at the River Ouse and ending at the Monks Cross Shopping Park.

- 01** Which **two rivers** flow through York?
The River Ouse splits the city into two parts, and to the east of it flows the »Foss«.
- 02** How long are the **city walls** of York? *Approximately 5.3 kilometers.*
- 03** Look up »**Monk Bar**« and find out what it is! How many »Bars« are there in York?
The word »Bar« means »gate« in Scottish. Thus, »Monk Bar« is a gate in the city walls in the north of the city. There are four gates in total: Bootham Bar, Monk Bar, Walmgate Bar, and Micklegate Bar.
- 04** The **York Minster** is the largest medieval church in England. Find out what the »Five Sisters« in the York Minster are.
The »Five Sisters« refer to the five lancet windows in the north transept of York Minster.
- 05** What is the name of the **garden** behind York Minster?
Dean's Park.
- 06** **York Castle** is now just a ruin. What is the remaining part called?
Clifford's Tower.
- 07** Go to the Jorvik Viking Centre. In the year 866, the city was captured by Danish Vikings and called Jorvik. The »**Jorvik Viking Festival**« is held every year. When and how long is it celebrated?
